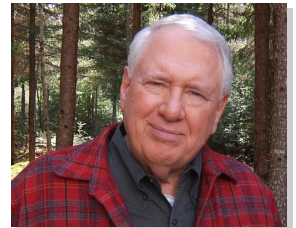

Workshop 2 – Succession Planning & Wealth Strategies

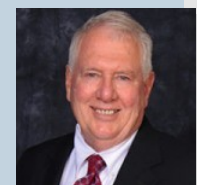
